In 1988, Bridges launched its first mobile outreach, bringing food, clothing and necessities to people experiencing homelessness under the Brooklyn Bridge in New York City. Today, with the help of more than 2,600 volunteers, we deliver 65,000 meals and necessities each year to 20,000 people in need in New York, Newark and Irvington. Every Friday, we open our doors to Summit neighbors in need. In 2014 Bridges established "Project Connect" in Newark, where professional case managers work with homeless clients individually to create an attainable set of goals to lead to better health and, ultimately, housing, a job and independence. In our first three years we helped 89 individuals experiencing homelessness find permanent homes.
